THE RULES:

- Contest is open to Cornell students only.
- The design should promote scientific exploration and contain the words “BOOM 2006” and the words “Bits On Our Minds”
- Submit your design(s) on a CD, as a .jpg or a .gif, and provide your original artwork file (Photoshop or equivalent).
- Label the CD with your name and netid and deliver it to 5147 Upson Hall by October 14, 2005.
- Full-color designs are preferred.
- You’ll need to provide two versions of the same logo:
 - ✓ One for web display (72 dpi), sized approximately 3x5"
 - ✓ One high-res for print (600 dpi), sized approximately 8x10"
